Re: Physical Education Policy Suiting out & Participation

- 1) Physical Education is an activity class. Students will participate in physical activity according to the P.E. curriculum. It will not be used as a study hall. Participation is the largest portion of the P.E. grade. Suiting out and cooperation is the other portion.
- 2) All CLCS students enrolled in P. E. Classes at all levels are required to dress out every day in specified school approved uniform Black shorts and Royal Blue T-Shirt for Junior High and High School Students. Elementary students will wear their school uniform. Substitute shorts or substitute T-shirts other than the school issued ones are unacceptable.
- 3) All P.E. students are required to participate in P.E. activities as instructed by their teacher.
- 4) All P.E. students are to be dressed and on time daily for P. E. class.
- 5) All P.E. students are to be responsible for their own P.E. uniform daily take it home, wash as needed and return for next day's class.
- 6) P.E. Students not dressing out will receive a ZERO for the day for P.E. class.
- 7) Students will receive a ZERO for every P.E. class period that they are not in required P.E.
- 8) No P.E. Students will be allowed to sit in the stands without P.E. teacher's instructions or permission. P. E. Class is an activity class and not a study hall.
- 9) Students who come to P.E. class not suited out will be sent to the Business Office to purchase a T-shirt & Shorts.
- 10) If said student does not have the money to pay, the Business office will bill their parents.
- 11) This process will be repeated two times for a total of three.
- 12) Three violations will result in disciplinary action from the Principal's office.
- 13) Signed Doctor's notes for sickness or injury will be an exception. Parental notes will be dealt with on an individual basis.
